Missionary of the Month:

Stephen & Pat Mosely

**Retired from Church Planting,
Portugal with TEAM**

Stephen and Pat Mosely, missionaries to Portugal for forty years, have been part of the Denbigh Baptist global staff since 1985. They are currently living in



New Jersey, where they feel God's direction for them now is to be caregivers to Pat's elderly, widowed mother. In August 1978, Steve answered God's call to do "team" missions in Portugal. About six years later, on a trip back to the states, he met and pursued his future wife, Pat. He remembers telling her that his proposal of marriage included an adventure. Pat, not afraid of adventure, accepted his proposal and has served alongside him in Portugal until their retirement from the field in August 2018. The couple has a son, Jon and a daughter, Stephanie. As of October 13, 2018 a son in-law has been added to their family.

Steve grew up in a loving family of an Air Force military dad, a mother, and two brothers. At home the boys were taught to obey parents, obey government, and be good citizens; however, the family was unchurched and void of any Christian influence. Steve, the middle son, was first in his family to receive God's gift of salvation. He began immediately to be a witness for Jesus, through word and action, and soon the family began to see something different about him and they were curious. Before long his mother and two brothers became Christians. A little while later Steve's dad came to know Jesus as well. God called all three of the Mosely sons into full time Christian service. Steve's brother, Bob Mosely, was Youth Director and Associate Pastor at Denbigh Baptist Church during the Pastorate of Rev. Herbert Arnold.
